



🇬🇧 The family name TATSCHKE presumably comes from the West Slavic language area with the main areas of settlement in the area of today's Wroclaw, Poland (then Wroclaw in Silesia) and Berlin (see chart).

The name could have been derived from the term ptaszek (ptak) and has been Germanized over the generations.

The word ptak exists in today's Polish, Czech and Sorbian languages and means the bird. The word ptaszek means little bird.

Presumably, the former settlers practiced in the Slavic language area the activity of Voglers (bird catcher).
